DRAWING FOR PAINTERS

On Track Studios, Franklin, TN / 9am - 4pm

PHOTO REFERENCE

Original photo reference of any subject matter. You can use digital reference on an iPad or laptop or printed reference, either is fine. Bring at least 12 images.

DRAWING SUPPLIES

Pencil and eraser, or vine charcoal & kneaded eraser
Sketch book ~ 9x12 - 12x16 size range (paper clipped to a board will also work)

CANVAS OR PANELS

You will need two. Suggested sizes can be from 12x16 to 16x20.
Bring the surface you like to paint on. You can stain the canvas if you wish.

As part of this class, you will be drawing on the canvases you bring with you. This will be in preparation for the painting stage to be completed outside of class time. You can accomplish these drawings by using charcoal and spraying with fixative (fixative provided) or you can go over the drawing lines with a water-soluble crayon (I will provide these for your use), which will not dissolve with solvent. You may rather draw with thinned down paint using a brush. Just bring the tools you need to get your drawing on the canvas to class. Note: the water soluble crayon will not work with water soluble oils.

BRUSHES

Bring your favorite drawing brush. You will use it to get the drawing down for the painting you will complete at home. I will provide you with palette, paint and solvent for this stage if you prefer to draw with paint..

EASELS & TRAY TABLES

Easels and tray tables are available for you at On Track Studios.
